

Mission Walk 2017 - terms and conditions

There are just a few last things for you to think about and agree to before you book your place on the North West Air Ambulance Charity's Mission Walk and start your fundraising journey.

The Mission Walk

1. The routes are not suitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs.
2. Only guide dogs are accepted, no other pets or animals are permitted due to livestock on the route.
3. As the walk is along quiet country roads, public footpaths and farm land, you must be mindful and considerate of the general public and local residents keeping noise to a minimum, disposing of litter responsibly and closing all gates to protect livestock.
4. The North West Air Ambulance Charity is not responsible for personal injury, accident, loss, damage or theft and public liability.
5. Entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
6. If the event is cancelled due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances, The North West Air Ambulance Charity accepts no responsibility for any costs incurred by participants.
7. The North West Air Ambulance Charity may publish or broadcast photographs or video of you participating in the event for the purpose of publicising the event and the work of the charity. If you are not happy for your images to be used for this purpose, you must inform the charity before the day of the event on fundraising@nwaa.net or 0800 587 4570.
8. The North West Air Ambulance Charity reserves the right to alter the route, timings and entertainment. The distance publicised was correct upon registration opening and may not be exact.

Your safety

9. You must comply with any safety guidelines or other event rules put in place by the event organisers, the North West Air Ambulance Charity's staff, volunteers or marshals.
10. You agree to participate in the event entirely at your own risk.
11. You know yours, and your child's ability, and it's your responsibility to ensure you are capable of completing your chosen route.
12. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
13. Suitable footwear and clothing should be worn at all times whilst completing the Mission Walk.
14. We recommend that you obtain personal accident insurance cover for the event.
15. If you are in any doubt as to your physical ability, or are aware of any medical conditions or impairments that may be detrimental to your health if you participate, you must consult your doctor and if necessary withdraw from the event.

Fundraising

16. Only use original sponsorship forms issued by The North West Air Ambulance Charity (or online sponsorship such as JustGiving).
17. You will forward all remaining proceeds from this event within 12 weeks after the event date.
18. Your place must not be used to raise money for any other charity.
19. Please inform the charity of any other fundraising activity that you carry out apart from collecting sponsorship.
20. You must not swap your walking number or offer your place to any other person if for any reason you are unable to participate.
21. Should you not take part in the event for any reason, return any sponsorship monies collected to your sponsors or if you are unable to do so forward them to The North West Air Ambulance Charity.

22. Please note that any sponsorship money you collect will be held by you on trust for The North West Air Ambulance Charity and failure to pay it to The North West Air Ambulance Charity or return it to donors is theft.
23. You must not do anything to harm The North West Air Ambulance Charity's good name and reputation and if requested by The North West Air Ambulance Charity, you must cease raising funds in aid of the charity.
